## COUNTLESS WAYS TO CREATE ADVENTURE

Sweetwater County is fortunate to be located in an area that provides world class recreation opportunities. We are the gateway to internationally known icons just a few hours away. These include Jackson Hole, Grand Teton National Park and Yellowstone National Park. Flaming Gorge National Recreation Area is in our backyard. It is a 91-mile-long lake with biking, camping, hiking, wildlife viewing, water sports, and World Class Trophy fishing all year long. The Killpecker Sand Dunes offer beautiful, soft dunes to explore, as well as the remains of a tumultuous geologic past in the form of buttes and spires including the 400-foot-tall Boar's Tusk, North Table Mountain, South Table Mountain, Black Rock, Spring Butte and the Leucite Hills. The dunes are abundant in wildlife with desert elk, majestic wild horses, and pronghorn antelope. While the information is wide-ranging, it is by no means a complete picture of our community and region.

Sweetwater County has a variety of healthcare options available for our residents. Memorial Hospital of Sweetwater County (MHSC) is just one of the many locations for healthcare in the County. MHSC is a non-profit, 99-bed, regional acute-care facility in southwestern Wyoming. The hospital has more than 500 employees, including more than 30 employed physicians providing care in more than two dozen specialty fields. MHSC offers care in ENT/otolaryngology, family medicine, general surgery, internal medicine, pediatrics, pulmonology, nephrology, obstetrics and women’s health, oncology, orthopedics and sports medicine, and urology. Services include cardiac rehabilitation, cardio and respiratory, diabetes education, dialysis, emergency care, intensive care, laboratory services, medical imaging, medical and surgical, nutrition therapy, rehabilitation and sleep disorder lab, as well as cardiology, vascular and maternal-fetal medicine services through its affiliation with University of Utah Health. Sweetwater Regional Cancer Center is an affiliate partner of the University of Utah’s Huntsman Cancer Institute.
